• Effect of social connectedness and spiritual intelligence on the romantic attachment of young adults

The purpose of this research was to study the effect of social connectedness and spiritual intelligence on romantic attachment of young adults of Delhi NCR. Non- probability sampling was used to collect data from 150 individuals in the age range of 18-25 years.

Results were analyzed using SPSS. Correlational analyses reveal that while there is a significant relationship between social connectedness and romantic attachment of young adults of Delhi NCR, there is no significant relationship between spiritual intelligence and romantic attachment of young adults of Delhi NCR. The results of the regression analysis further reveal that social connectedness accounts for 32.2% of the variance in close romantic attachment, 15.7% of the variance in dependent romantic attachment and 9% of the variance in anxious romantic attachment of young adults of Delhi NCR. Further research is required to explore and understand the variables affecting the romantic attachment of young adults of Delhi NCR.
